Software use includes current industry standard, Adobe Creative Suite - InDesign, Illustrator, Photoshop and Flash. Units include paste-up, silk screening, scratch pads, elements of design, typography, small space ads, digital photography and poster design. Troubleshoot equipment including computers and printers. Produce real-world work for high school: posters, flyers, advertisements.
